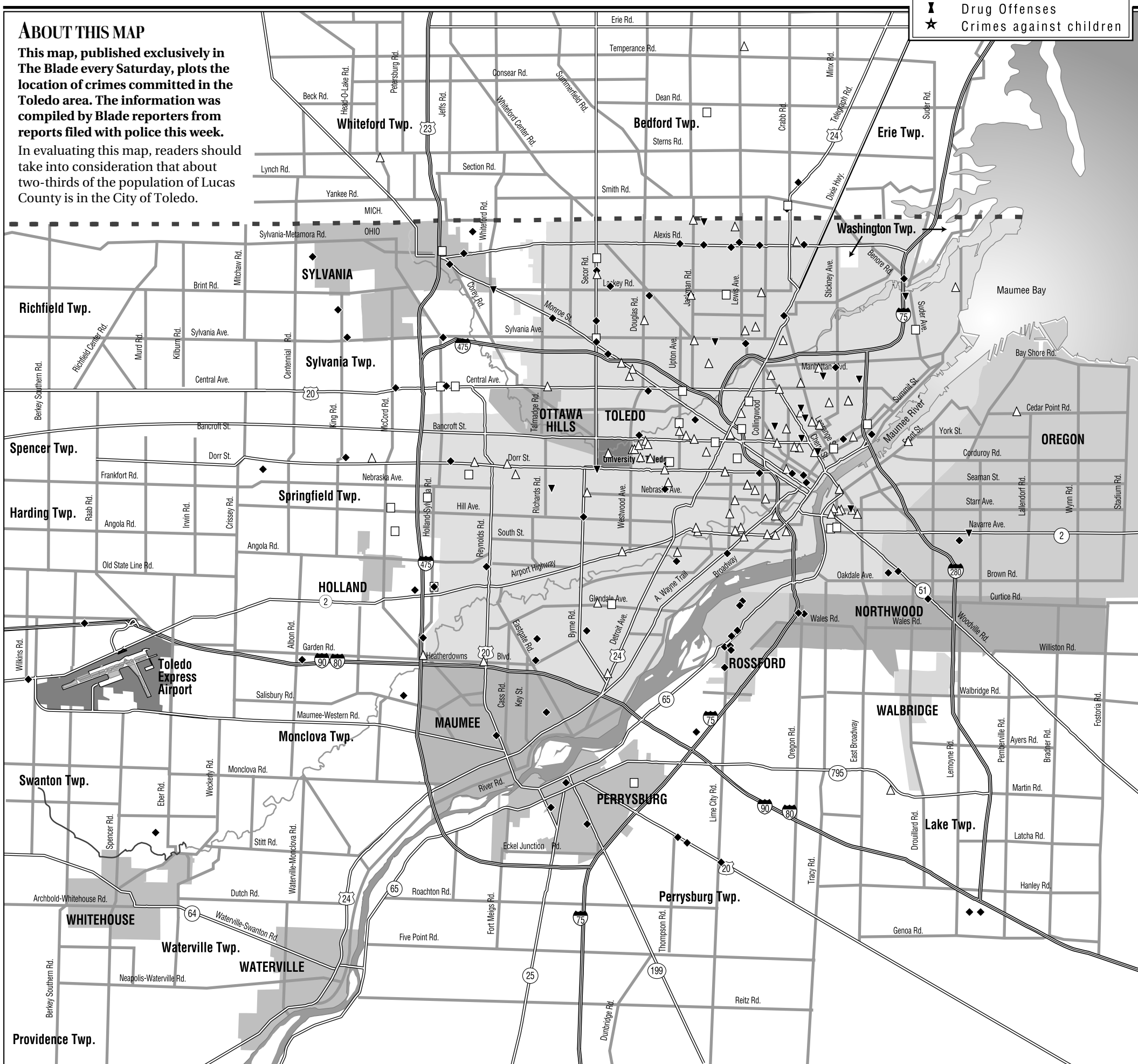

Clues are needed about Nov. assault

Toledo police are seeking information through the Crime Stopper program about a man who sexually assaulted a 53-year-old West Toledo woman.

The woman had taken a bath in her home in the 4500 block of Clover Lane about 7:30 p.m. Nov. 8.

When she went to leave the room, a man pushed her to the floor, assaulted her, then fled. He is described as black, with



a light complexion and blond hair, about 5 feet, 10 inches tall, and 280 pounds. He was wearing a nylon stocking on his head, a black hooded coat, and a gold wedding band.

Stepped-up patrols planned for I-75, Dorr-Secor

I-75 between I-475 and the Anthony Wayne Trail, as well as the intersection of Dorr Street and Secor Road, will be the focus of a target enforcement program from Monday to Jan. 14.

Toledo police will crack down on speeding and other traffic violations in those areas. The effort was funded with \$67,187.99 from state and federal grants.

Murder suspect arrested, to be arraigned Monday

A Toledo man charged in connection with the city's last homicide of 2006 was arrested without incident yesterday and is to be arraigned Monday in Toledo Municipal Court.

Charles Mickey Rodriguez, 21, whose last known address was 921 Homer Ave., was arrested in an apartment at 336 14th St. about 10 a.m., police said.

The Northern Ohio Violent Fugitive Task Force took him into custody after police received information about his location.

He was interviewed and booked into the Lucas County jail.

Mr. Rodriguez is charged

with murder in the death Sunday of General Hurst, 22, who was shot in front of a North Toledo convenience store.

Mr. Hurst walked out of the Dairy Mart, 3380 Lagrange St., shortly after 11:30 p.m.

He was confronted by an armed suspect. He was shot as he tried to get away, police said.

Mr. Hurst stumbled to the 200 block of East Pearl Street before collapsing in a yard there. He died a short time later at St. Vincent Mercy Medical Center.

Court records indicate Mr. Rodriguez fired six shots, one of which hit Mr. Hurst in the back.

Fulton County probes vehicle thefts

SWANTON — The Fulton County Crime Stopper Program is seeking information about several vehicle thefts that occurred last month in Fulton Township, north of Swanton.

Some of the unlocked cars and all-terrain vehicles had the keys in them. Many vehicles have been recovered, including a Jeep Wrangler taken from 3222 County Road K; a Honda utility vehicle taken from 9298 State Rt.

64; a Plymouth Sundance taken from 10285 County Road 3, and a silver Dodge Caravan taken from 9927 State Rt. 64.

Missing is a Yamaha Y45 orange and black all-terrain vehicle taken from 10683 County Road 4. Anyone with information about the thefts is asked to call the Crime Stopper Program at 1-800-255-1122. Callers may remain anonymous and could be eligible for a \$1,000 reward.

2 men charged with stealing coins from machine

GLANDORF, Ohio — Two men accused of trying to steal cash from a coin machine appeared in Putnam County Court yesterday.

Richard L. Dailey, 52, of Knoxville, Tenn., and Charles W. Stevens, 38, Lancaster, Ohio, were

arrested Thursday night on tampering charges after the owner of Old Town Car Wash reported suspicious activity. Police later stopped the men in a truck. A large number of quarters and other material were found in the vehicle, authorities said.
