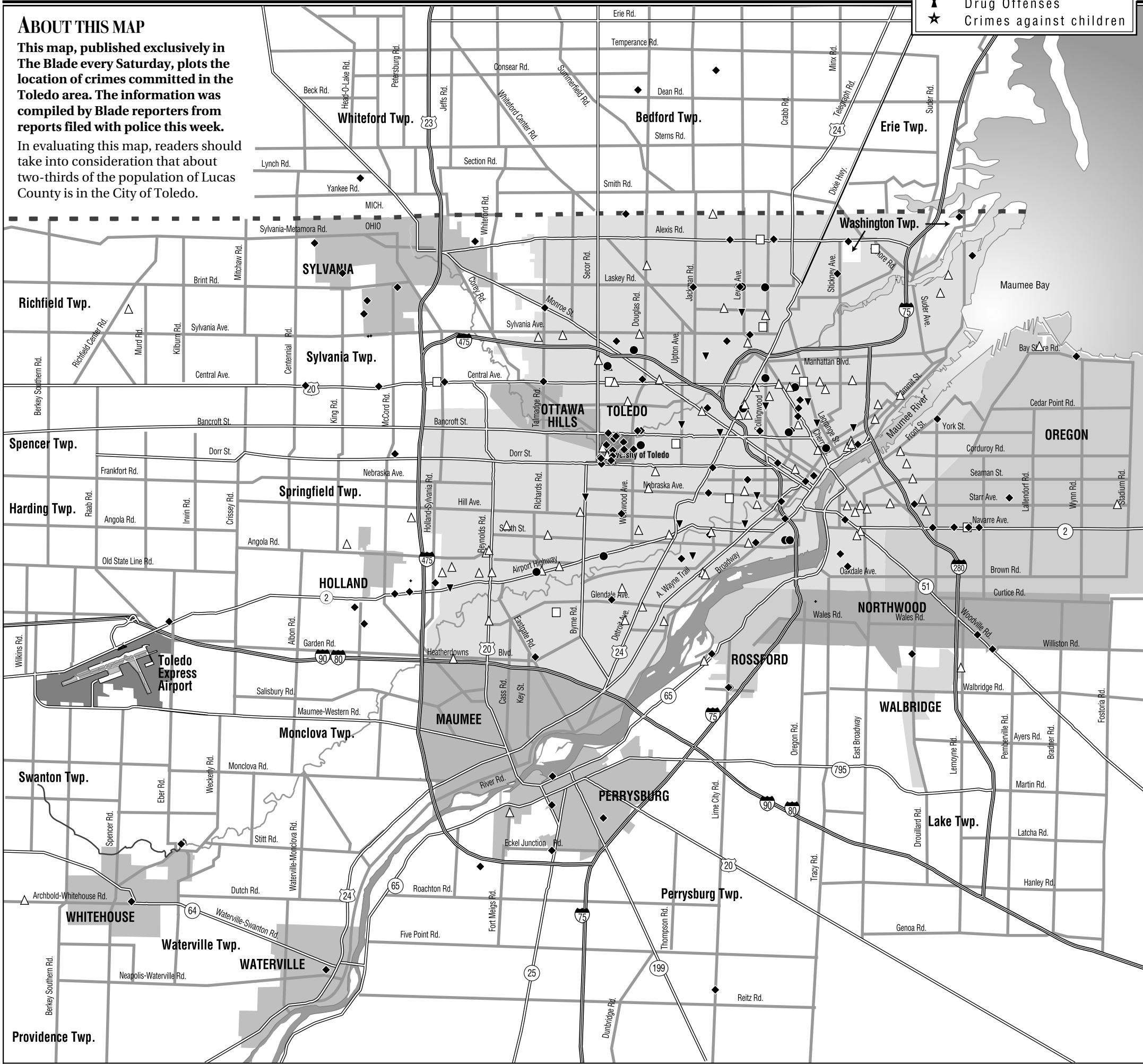

## 1 held in stabbings of man, dog

A South Toledo man accused of stabbing another man and then killing that man's dog in Swan Creek Metropolitan Park in the 4300 block of Airport Highway Wednesday night is being held in the Lucas County jail without bond, authorities said.



**Hamilton**

Antuane Hamilton, 35, of 1539 Secor Rd., was arrested about 8:45 a.m. yesterday at Toledo Municipal Court, authorities said. He was charged with felonious assault and killing

or injuring animals and will be arraigned Monday in municipal court.

Fernando Gonzalez, Jr., 26, of South Toledo had finished jogging with his cousin and Rottweiler, Ceelo, at the park about 8:10 p.m. Wednesday when a man yelled to him. According to police, Hamilton was arguing with a woman in the park before he approached Gonzalez.

Hamilton apparently wanted to know why Gonzalez, who was listening to music on his iPod, was looking at him.

As the man got closer, Gonzalez said Hamilton challenged him to a fight. And when Gon-

zalez didn't back down, the man pulled out a knife, he said.

Gonzalez grabbed the knife to defend himself but was stabbed below his left eye. Gonzalez's cousin let Ceelo out of Gonzalez's truck to go after the man. He took off and Ceelo followed closely behind. Hamilton is accused of stabbing the dog, police said.

Gonzalez grabbed a golf club from his truck and started chasing the man, who fled into a nearby wooded area.

Two women who saw the attack and Gonzalez's cousin took Ceelo to an animal hospital, where the dog died shortly after.

## 3 sought in man's assault

Toledo police are seeking information through the Crime Stopper program about an assault on a man yesterday in central Toledo, authorities said.

John Kimble, 71, of the 3200 block of Collingwood Boulevard, walked to his front yard to take out the trash about 12:20 a.m. when three men, each with a gun, approached, police said.

The suspects demanded money and assaulted Mr. Kimble, causing facial cuts and possible head injuries, police said.

Mr. Kimble was taken to St. Vincent Mercy Medical Center, where a nursing supervisor said yesterday she had no informa-



tion on a patient by that name. The suspects were described as black men, police said.

Anyone with information is asked to call the Crime Stopper program. Callers may remain anonymous and could be eligible for a cash reward.

At one point, McPartland slammed on the brakes and drove backward into Deputy Crawford's cruiser.

The McPartland vehicle's exhaust pipe was damaged, disabling the engine and allowing deputies to arrest McPartland, authorities said.

Authorities said they found a weapon in his vehicle, which they believe was displayed by the robber during some of the robberies.
