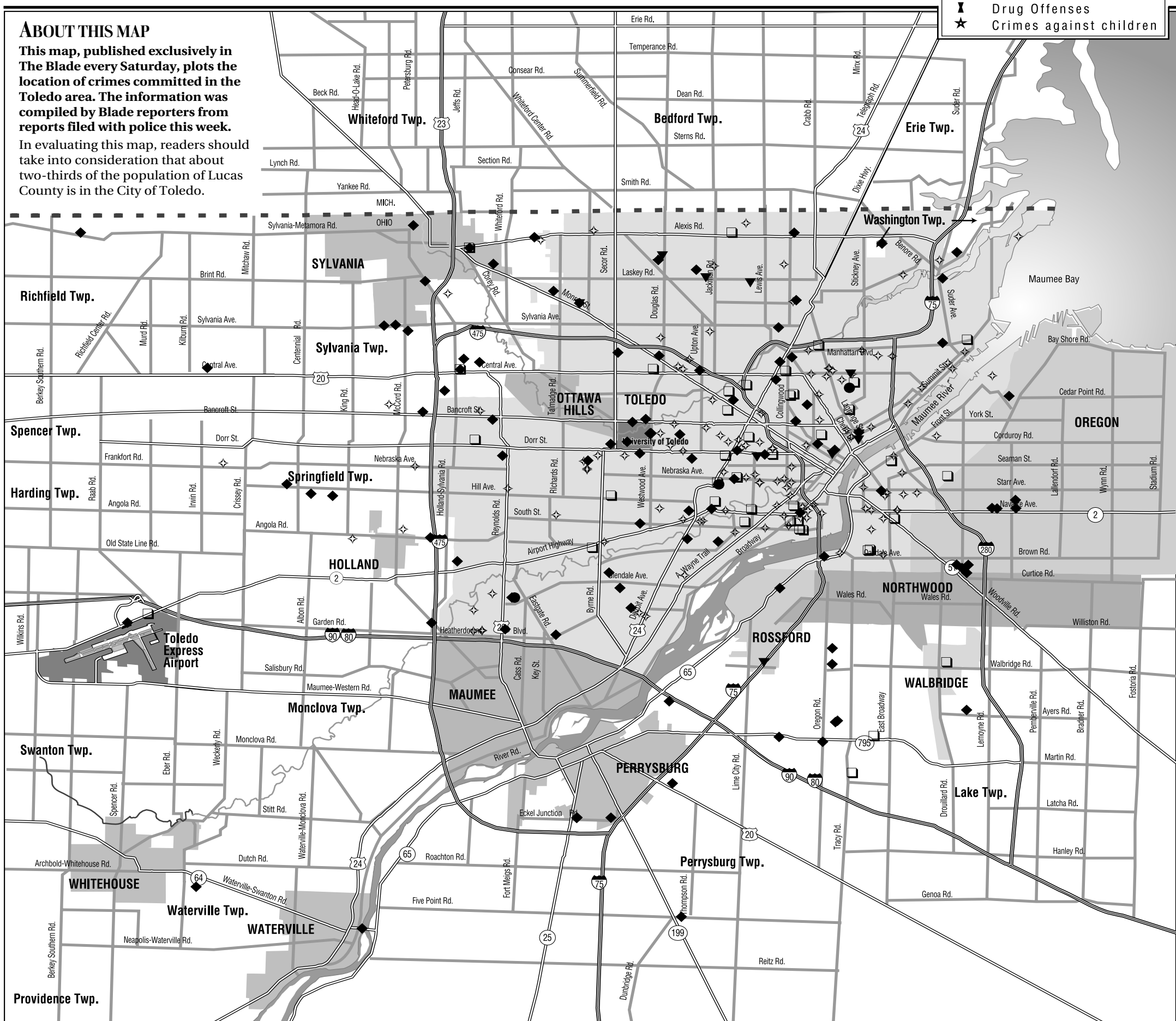

# 2 robberies may be related, police say



Toledo police are seeking information through the Crime Stopper program about two robberies this week that they believe were committed by the same suspects.

The first occurred on Sunday when a South Toledo man was approached in the parking lot of 240 21st St. at about 5:30 a.m. Two men, one brandishing a pistol, approached the 38-year-old man and took a

black Ford Explorer he was driving, police said.

The other holdup happened

two days later, when a 55-year-old woman was robbed of a change purse outside her apartment building in the 700

block of Locust Street at about 12:40 p.m., police said.

Both suspects were described as black, in their 20s, with thin builds and about 5 feet, 10 inches tall.

Anyone with information is asked to call the Crime Stopper program.

Callers may remain anonymous and may be eligible for a cash reward.

## Impaired drivers to get Super Bowl attention

Some law enforcement agencies in northwest Ohio have received state and federal grants to pay for extra officers to patrol roads during Super Bowl weekend to look for impaired drivers.

The Lucas County Traffic Safety Program and members of the county drunk driving task force have received state grants to allow for police overtime today and tomorrow, said Frank Arvay, a lieutenant with the Sylvania Township police department

and a task force coordinator.

He said Toledo police and the Lucas County Sheriff's Office will help with the patrols.

Ottawa Hills will have extra officers out tomorrow, a dispatcher said.

Outside Lucas County, a few agencies have reported they will have extra crews on the roads during and after the game tomorrow, including the Ohio Highway Patrol posts in Lima, Defiance, and Sandusky and the

Erie County Sheriff's Office.

Perrysburg Township will keep watch today and tomorrow on State Rts. 20, 25, and 795, looking for impaired drivers and seat-belt violations.

The Michigan State Police post in Monroe has sought help from the Monroe County Sheriff's Office and the Monroe Police Department. They will have increased patrols throughout the county all weekend, state police Sgt. Mike Roberts said.

## Central-Secor intersection, stretch of I-75 to face special scrutiny

The intersection of Central Avenue and Secor Road, and I-75 between I-475 and the Anthony Wayne Trail will be the focuses of

the special traffic enforcement program through Feb. 12.

Toledo police will crack down on speeding and other violations

in those areas.

The officers' overtime is covered by a \$71,631 grant from state and federal agencies.
