NOE, during the time period beginning March 31, 1998, and continuing through May 26, 2005, in Lucas County, Ohio, did, while employed by or associated with any enterprise, conduct or participate in, directly or indirectly, the affairs of the enterprise through a pattern of corrupt activity in violation of §2923.32(A)(1) OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, ENGAGING IN A PATTERN OF CORRUPT ACTIVITY, BEING A FELONY OF THE FIRST DEGREE, contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

THE JURORS OF THE GRAND JURY further find and present the following real and personal property was used in the course of or intended to be used in the course of a violation of Revised Code Section 2923.32 (A) (1) or that the real and/or personal property was derived from or realized through conduct in violation of Revised Code Section 2923.32 (A)(1), and that THOMAS W. NOE'S interest therein is subject to forfeiture pursuant to Revised Code Section 2923.32 (B)(3):
