



DAVID PATCH Road Warrior

The Blade's Road Warrior advises readers each Friday where the biggest driving headaches will be throughout the construction season. He'll tell you the locations to avoid and the detours to take.

Bridge-deck repairs on northbound I-75 will require single-lane traffic for two nights next week, the Ohio Department of Transportation announced.

Avoid Airport Highway between Reynolds and Holland-Sylvania roads starting on Monday: a culvert replacement near Bernath Parkway will reduce the street to one lane each way.

Until this construction ends in mid-August, use Angola Road or Heatherdowns Boulevard as an alternate route into Springfield Township.

Starting at 9 p.m. Monday, two of three lanes will be closed at Miami Street and the ramp from southbound Miami to northbound I-75 will be closed. Work is sched-

uled to end by 6 a.m. Tuesday. During the same hours Tuesday night into Wednesday morning, the single-lane zone will start at the State Rt. 25 North/Downtown exit

(201B).Between 7:30 a.m. and 4 p.m. on weekdays next week, varying lane closings are planned in the same area for sweeping and drain

1. I-75: Single and double lane closings between I-280 and Exit 2 in Michigan; the two-lane closings occur at night. Occasional, short-term ramp closings may also



2. State Rt. 51 (Monroe Street): Full-time lane closings, Whiteford to Alexis.



3. U.S. 20: Occasional flag zones and side-road detours required for widening project, Woodville to State Rt. 420. State Rt. 105 is closed at

U.S. 20 for intersection work until September.



4. I-280: Northbound I-280 RAMP CLOSED exit to Curtice, including connector from Woodville, is closed for reconstruction.

Use Lemoyne between Woodville and Curtice. Intermittent lane closings on I-280 at Brown.



5. I-75, I-475: Nighttime lane closings on I-75 between Detroit and Stickney and on I-475 between I-75 and Secor.

Work hours are 10 p.m. to 4 a.m.



6. Jackman Road: Closed until mid-October at the Halfway Creek bridge near the Ohio-Michigan border. Detour via Alexis, Lewis, and Smith.



Lagrange Street: Lane closings between Central and Detroit.



8. State Rt. 64: Closed until month's end between State Rts. 65 and 582.



9. I-75: Nighttime lane closings at Lincoln. Nearby ramps may also be closed. Lincoln closed at I-75 bridge.



10. State Rt. 2: Traffic reduced to one lane each way between Holland-Sylvania and Bernath, starting Monday and



continuing until mid-August. 11. State Rt. 295: Closed

between State Rt. 64 and Reed, 7 a.m. to 3 p.m., daily starting Monday.



12. U.S. 24: Intermittent daytime lane closings, Water-

ville to State Rt. 109, starting Monday and continuing through September.



13. State Rt. 25: Northbound right lane closed intermittently, Reitz to Five Point, through September.



14. I-75: Two of three lanes closed Monday night at Miami and Tuesday night at Erie. Varying daytime lane closings, Erie to Wales.

OFF THE MAP



I-75 (Mich.): Closed in Detroit between Clark and Rosa Parks, and two of

three northbound lanes closed from South Rockwood through Gibraltar. Use I-275 and I-94 instead.



I-75 (Ohio): Nighttime lane closings, North Baltimore to Cygnet, Sunday through Thursday nights. Intermit-

tent lane closings at State Rt. 103 near Bluffton.



U.S. 20A: Intermittent lane closings in western Fulton County, today only from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.



U.S. 23: Varying lane closings at U.S. 30 and State Rt. 53 interchanges near Upper Sandusky, Ohio.



U.S. 24: Closed between State Rt. 109 and the Napoleon bypass through August. Detour via State

Rts. 109 and 110 and U.S. 6. Heavy vehicles must use U.S. 6, I-75, and I-475. Intermittent flag zones and speed restrictions between Napoleon and the Defiance-Paulding county line.



State Rt. 15/U.S. 68: One lane each way at Lima Avenue, just south of I-75



junction in Findlay. State Rt. 163: Closed near Oak Harbor High School.



Detour via State Rts. 590 and 105.



State Rt. 281: Singlelane traffic, governed by a temporary stoplight, on the Maumee River bridge near Defiance.
