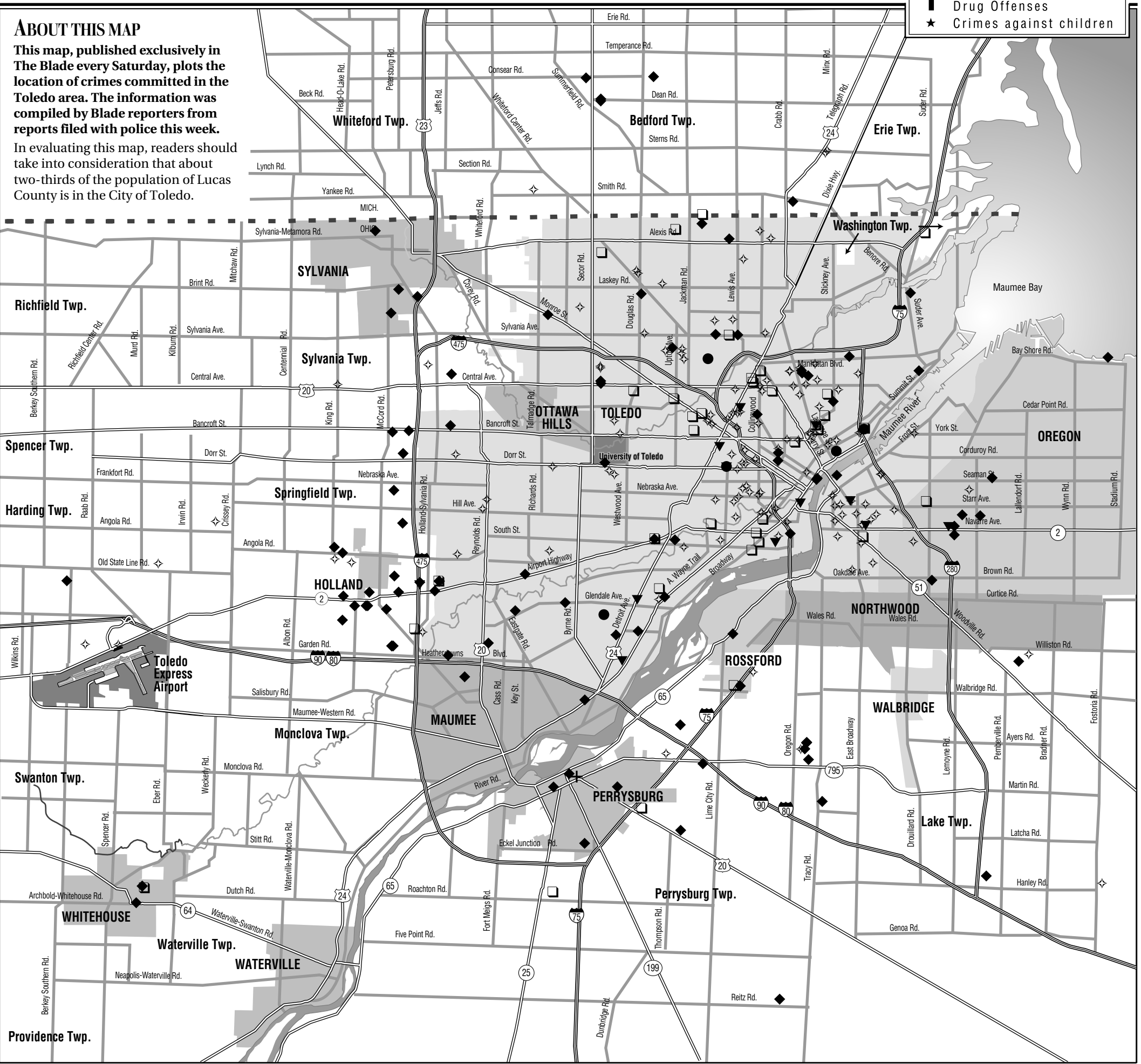

Clues sought in robbery, assault at VFW post

Toledo police are seeking information through the Crime Stopper program about a robbery May 17 at a VFW post in which a man was hit in the back of the head with a handgun.

Troy Hall, 42, left through the back door of the post, 415 East Central Ave., about 11 p.m. The assailant forced him back inside, took money from the safe, and

hit Mr. Hall in the head with the gun, police said.

The man also took a videocassette recorder before fleeing.

He was described as black, 6 feet, 2 inches tall, weighing about 175 pounds, and wearing black clothing and black do-rag.

Anyone with information is asked to call the Crime Stopper program. Callers may remain



anonymously and may be eligible for a cash reward.

Glendale Avenue, stretch of I-75 targets of special traffic enforcement

Glendale Avenue at Byrne Road and I-75 between I-475 and Miami Street will be the focus of Toledo's special traffic enforcement program through June 4. Police will crack down on speeding and other violations in those areas.

Officers' overtime is covered through \$71,631 in state and federal grant money.

Area law enforcement agencies also will have extra patrols out during the three-day Memorial Day weekend. The Lucas County Sheriff's Office will enforce speed and seat belt laws primarily on Airport Highway, Central Avenue, and U.S. 24. Their effort is covered through grant money.

Perrysburg Township police

have received a grant from the Ohio Department of Public Safety to conduct selective traffic enforcement within the township. Township police will target State Rts. 20, 25, and 795 during the weekend and from June 2 through June 4. They will be working additional hours funded by the grant, which will run through September.
