## 1

■ Jersey number of BG's top running back Willie Geter, who started in only one game a year ago. In his lone start, the Miami, Fla. native exploded for 160 yards on 12 carries, including a 70-yard touchdown run in a win over Toledo.

## 2

■ BG first-year coach Dave Clawson was named the Division I-AA coach of the year twice, claiming the honor once at Fordham and once at Richmond.

■ BG games scheduled for one of the ESPN networks — Boise State (Sept. 26, ESPN360.com), Central Michigan (Oct. 24, ESPN Plus/GamePlan), at Buffalo (Nov. 3, ESPN2) and against Akron (Nov. 20, ESPNU).

■ Returning starters back in uniform from the 2008 season. Eight of the 11 are starters on offense, three on the defensive side.

■ Games quarterback Tyler Sheehan has played in during his four-year career. He has started 25 straight games.

■ Receptions wide receiver Freddie Barnes hauled in while playing only nine games last season. It is tops among the returning receivers and ranked second overall last season.

■ Punting average last year for Nick Iovinelli, who made the All-MAC third team.

■ Years since the Falcons finished undefeated with a 9-0 record and claimed the small college national championship.

## 66.8

■ Sheehan's completion percentage a year ago, which ranks No. 2 all-time for a Falcon quarterback for a single season.

## 95

■ Tackles defensive back P.J. Mahone recorded last year, tops on the team.
