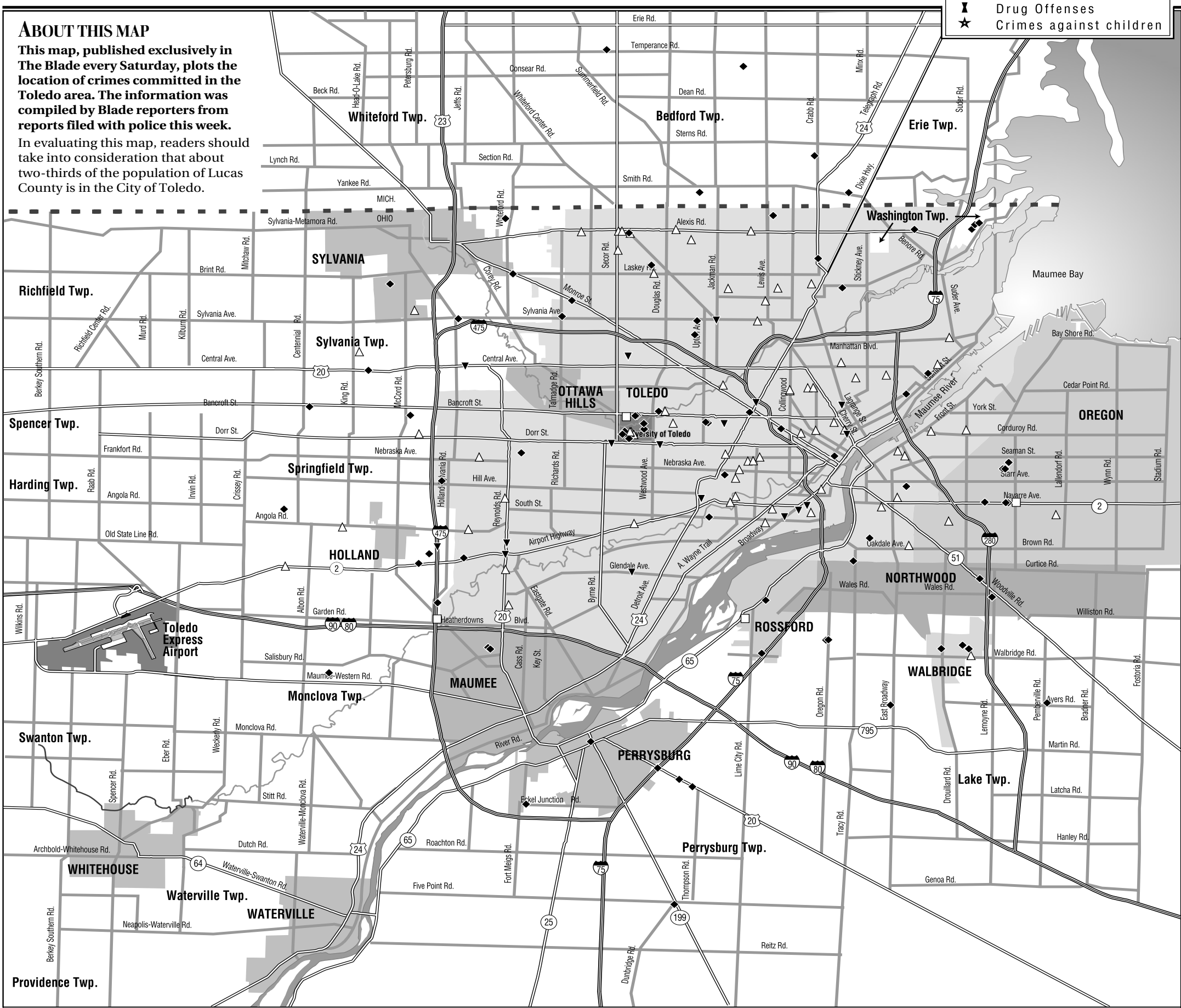

Police hunt tenant from site where body was discovered

Toledo police are seeking information through the Crime Stopper program on the whereabouts of Willie Washington, who was a second-floor tenant at 1025 Marmion Ave., where the body of Gordon Wright was discovered about 8:30 p.m. Feb. 13 after the duplex was set on fire, authorities said. Wright, who had been killed, died before the fire was started at the central city house on the corner of Marmion and Midway Plaisance Street. Flames were visible from the second floor when firefighters arrived. The fire was under control about 8:45 p.m. Fire Investigator Andre Tiggs said several fires were set on the second floor, causing about \$14,000 in damage. After the fire was under con-

trol, firefighters on the third floor broke through a half wall to check whether the fire had spread and found the body, authorities said. The body was well concealed in the attic, and it was "by chance" that firefighters found it, authorities said. Wright's body had been inside the house for "at least a couple of days," police said. His death is Toledo's first homicide this year. An autopsy showed Wright died from blunt head injuries, according to Dr. Cynthia Beisser, a Lucas County deputy coroner. She said there were no

other injuries. Mr. Washington has two aliases, including Gregory Allen and Gregory Harris. He has not been seen since the early morning hours of Feb. 13. Mr. Washington had formerly lived on Hamilton Street and Central Avenue, police said. He is described as 50 years old, about 5 feet, 7 inches tall, and weighing 170 pounds. Mr. Washington has a tracheotomy scar on his throat, police said. Anyone with information is asked to call the Crime Stopper program. Callers may remain anonymous and could be eligible for a cash reward.

U.S. Marshals look for escapee, man wanted in credit card fraud

U.S. Marshals in Toledo are seeking information on the whereabouts of a convicted felon who escaped Sept. 6, 2007, from the Lucas County work-release program as well as a man wanted for credit card and loan fraud. Ryan Goucher, 34, was convicted in April on two counts of robbery and sentenced to five years of community control and three months in the county work-release program. He is a known drug user and has a criminal history of domestic violence, battery, and theft. Goucher was described as being about 5 feet, 11 inches tall and weighing 150 pounds, authorities said.

Carlos Peak, 37, is wanted by the U.S. Secret Service for credit card and loan fraud. Authorities said he is known to stay with his father on Southard Avenue near downtown Toledo. He has a criminal history of assault, weapons, and drug charges. He was described as being about 5 feet, 5 inches tall and weighing 145 pounds and has a tattoo of a bulldog on his chest, authorities said. Anyone with information is asked to call the Toledo office of the U.S. Marshals Service at 1-866-4-WANTED. Callers may remain anonymous and could be eligible for a cash reward.

Suspect arraigned in purse snatching

A South Toledo man who authorities said stole a 68-year-old woman's purse and then dragged her on the ground as he fled was arraigned yesterday in Toledo Municipal Court on a robbery charge. Garland Chapman, 23, of 1467 Ingomar Ave., is being held in the Lucas County jail in lieu of a \$25,000 bond. Ruth Jones was at the TARTA bus stop at Broadway and South Avenue about 4:30 p.m. Thursday when a man sat next to her, began talking, grabbed her purse, and fled, police said. Ms. Jones held onto her purse and was dragged on the ground as Mr. Chapman ran westbound on South Avenue. Several witnesses chased Mr. Chapman and restrained him until police arrived.
